As the world's first victim of atomic bomb, we, the Japanese people, have experienced first hand the horror of nuclear weapons. We cannot allow the disasters of Hiroshima and Nagasaki to be repeated. For that reason, we call upon all the nations of the world to abolish nuclear weapons and carry out total disarmament.

The idea of eternal peace is enshrined in Japanese Constitution. In order to preserve this idea in the lives of our citizens, and to pass it to down to our children and grandchildren, Uji City hereby declares itself a city dedicated to peace and the abolition of nuclear weapons.
