Glass bottles / PET bottles

□ / every other week before 9:00

Examples for glass bottles
Beverage, liquor, food and seasoning bottles

Examples for PET bottles
Beverage, soy sauce, mirin and sake recyclable bottles

Exceptions
cosmetic bottles, glassware, ceramic ware, light bulbs, fluorescent lights, thermometers, the other plastic bottles

How to dispose
remove caps
empty out all contents
put them into transparent or white translucent bag

«Glass bottles» «PET bottles»
Please remove caps from bottles.

Exceptions
styrene foam beverage, liquor and seasoning bottles.

“Pla Mark” (plastic container packaging)

□ / every week before 9:00

Examples for “Pla Mark”
marked plastic containers and packaging

Exceptions
styrene foam should be placed in “Pla Mark”

Exceptions
CD/DVD, video tapes and cases, items made of plastic (lunch boxes, paperwares, toys, etc.)

How to dispose
empty out all contents
rinse out
put them into transparent or white translucent bag

Cans

1st and 3rd or 2nd and 4th Wed. / every month before 9:00

Examples for cans
BEER, COFFEE, beverage, food, and cookie cans

Exceptions
large sized frying pots, kettles, aluminum cans, spray cans, metal foil

How to dispose
empty out all contents
rinse out
put them into transparent or white translucent bag

Spray cans are exceptions. See below.

Milk cartons

Take milk cartons to the shops which accept collecting box.

with white interior
rinse out
cut open the cartons and dry
tie up
put into collecting box

Burnable waste

□ □ / every week before 9:00 or 13:00

Examples for burnable waste
kitchen garbage (drain water well before disposing), paper waste, packing tape, bamboo skewers (break and wrap in paper or packing tape), disposal diapers (remove the soil), small amount of garden waste (three bunches or less, 5 centimeters or less in diameter), dust in a vacuum cleaner

dry batteries used
put into transparent bag separated from other waste
rechargeable batteries and button-type batteries returned to the store you bought them

Used paper

Collection days are designated by each neighborhood association.

cardboards (the tip), newspapers, fliers (the tip), magazines, other papers (the tip), old clothes (put them into transparent or white translucent bag)

Unburnable waste

□ / every week before 9:00

Examples for unburnable waste
metal ware, ceramic ware, items made of plastic, glassware, light bulbs (wrap in newspaper, etc. and label “割れ物” and put them into transparent or white translucent bag), small furniture, packing tape, needle, razor (wrap in paper or packing tape), ashes (moisten and put into a bag), futon, carpets (fold up and bundle with a string), cooking stoves, stoves (remove batteries and kerosene)

spray cans and cassette cylinders
hiss
be sure to empty
put into transparent or white translucent bag for unburnable waste separately

Extra waste (with charges)
temporary/large amount of waste by moving or pruning
large size refuse
There is a charge for collecting these. Call waste management office.

Bodies of pets (with charges)
collect and dispose in an incinerator for animals (stray animals are free to collect.)

PC
computer devices (display), notebook computers

Office waste
Television (cathode-ray tube, LC plasma), Air conditioner, Refrigerator, Freezer, Washing machine, Cloth dryer
Fees for recycling and collection/transport are charged. Please call waste management office for details.

We cannot collect the following items
tires, motorcycles, batteries, gas cylinders, syringes, fire extinguishers, blocks, building waste, gasoline, oil, kerosene, agricultural chemicals, paint, industrial waste
(Return them to the store or consult with the dealer.)

Public holidays, we collect these waste as usual.
